MetroLink Instructions from Lambert St. Louis International Airport to Washington University

Purchase a MetroLink One-Ride ticket at any MetroLink ticket vending machine—this will cover your transfer. As of this printing, the MetroLink cost is \$2.50 each way.

Please note that fare boxes at the stations accept \$1, \$5, \$10 & \$20 bills (no \$2 bills). Please visit the metro website at www.metrostlouis.org if you wish to see video instructions on how to use the fare box.



- 1. Follow the signs in the airport terminal towards the MetroLink.
- 2. Board the Eastbound train with "Shiloh-Scott" on the destination display. Take this train to the Forest Park-DeBaliviere station and deboard.
- 3. Walk to the other side of the platform and wait for a Westbound train with "Shrewsbury/I-44" on the destination display. Take this train to the University City-Big Bend station and deboard. You will be on the northwest corner of the Washington University campus when you exit the station.
- 4. To walk from Big Bend station to Liggett House for check-in: Referring to the Danforth campus map, walk south on Big Bend and turn left onto Forsyth, make a right onto Wallace Dr. Once on Wallace go straight to access Wallace garage if driving, if walking go right on Shepley to arrive at Liggett or the Summer Programs Office located in Umrath House Suite 1950, right next to Bear Necessitites.

Note: If you're arriving on Saturday, June 22 between 12 and 3 p.m., go to Liggett House to check in. If you're arriving outside these hours, please check in at the Summer Programs Office located in Umrath House, identified by the light blue arrow on the South 40 map.
